## PARENT/GUARDIAN PERMISSION FOR STUDENT TO RECEIVE INSTRUCTION ON HUMAN GROWTH AND DEVELOPMENT AND AIDS

As stated in Florida Statute 1003.42(3), any student whose parent makes written request to the school principal shall be exempted from the teaching of reproductive health or any disease, including HIV/AIDS, its symptoms, development, and treatment. A student so exempted may not be penalized by reason of that exemption.

Curriculum materials are provided by the Florida Department of Health in Sarasota County. Current resources include *Making a Difference! An Abstinence-Based Approach to HIV/STD and Teen Pregnancy Prevention.* Topics include:

- HIV and other sexually transmitted diseases
- Disease prevention
- Teen pregnancy prevention

According to the Next Generation Sunshine State Standards, science courses in the middle grades include the following topics:

- Reproductive System
- Human Growth and Development
